The region is characterized by deep water, and at it southernmost point fringes on the outermost extent of the Nile delta. The region is also structurally complex and tectonically active to the West and South West. No public announcements have yet been made, but local media have reported that 2 consortia have been selected to carry out exploration activities in 2008.
